Community Health Worker PT/FT (Temporary Position)

Good Samaritan Health Centers of Gwinnett is seeking a Community Health Worker (CHW) to serve as a COVID Vaccine Advocate. A CHW acts as a liaison between health and social services and the community to facilitate access to services and improve the quality and cultural competence of service delivery. This position can be part-time or full-time based on the availability of the candidate with an ask that 24-40 hours are performed weekly. Duties of the position include:

- Speaking with patients as they enter Good Sam Gwinnett clinics and educating them about the benefits of the vaccine.
- Encouraging patients via phone to complete the series of COVID-19 vaccines.
- Directing patients with questions or concerns to local vaccination clinics and/or providers.
- Answering questions regarding vaccine hesitancy.
- Basic data entry.

This is a <u>temporary position</u> with a projected end date of <u>October 31, 2022</u>. Bilingual candidates are encouraged to apply, but it is not a requirement to speak Spanish for the position. We offer competitive pay and an optional benefits package.
